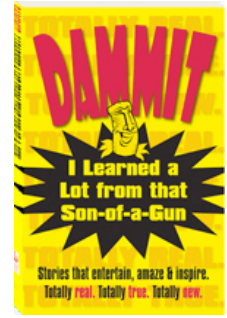


## Book Discussion Questions – For Most Book Clubs

Do you think it's good or bad to talk to strangers? Why?
